Notes to go with price list

- Children under 2 years old must attend for a minimum of 4 sessions or 2 days a week. Children 2 years plus for a minimum of 2 sessions or 1 dav a week.
- Parents/carers to provide breast milk/formula milk
- Parent/carers are to provide nappies, baby wipes, creams, suntan lotion, spare clothes. hats, outdoor waterproof suits and wellies.
- Six weeks' notice, in writing, is required when you alter your child's attendance or when a child leaves the nursery or six weeks' fees are pavable in lieu of notice.
- Late collection of a child after 1.00pm or 6.00pm will incur a £10 fee for first 10 minutes. Over 10 minutes late a full session fee will apply. This also applies to FREE entitlement children.
- Early Bird from 7.30am must be pre-booked, extra charge of £10.
- · Planned attendance is charged and should your child be absent for whatever reason, a refund will not be applied. This includes illnesses/medication/injections etc. (please see Communicable Diseases Chart)
- Registration fee of £40 payable when your nursery place is confirmed.
- Open 51 weeks a year closed between Christmas and New Year and on Statutory Bank Holidays (no charge) .
- We support our emergency services 10% off for NHS & Blue Light Card holders.
- Family friendly we offer 10% off sibling fees. (discount applied to lowest fee).
- There are **no multiple discounts.** Only the single biggest saving will be applied to your invoice.

In the case of full week, this will be 15% off invoice after FREE entitlement deducted

Fee Payment

- Invoices are itemised and are due in advance, for example, an invoice for days in September will be issued mid-August and fees due on 1st September. If you are paying via Tax Free Childcare please make an extra 3-5 day allowance for processing time.
- Fees paid via Tax Free Childcare this must be submitted 3 working davs prior to the 1st of the month
- Late payment will incur a £75 fee.
- We offer a wide range of payment options via Debit/Credit Card, Electronic transfer. Tax Free Childcare or cash.

9 MONTHS OLD OFFER

To access FREE 15 hours term time from September 2024 your child must have been born before 31 December 2023. If their birthday is between 1 January and 31 March 2024, they will be eligible for Government support from Spring term, January 2025.

To be eligible for Government are included schemes funding in fees

 You and your partner must earn on average at least £167 per week

(equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum wage or Living wage)

• No parent can earn over £100,000 a year

Funding support starts the term after your child's birthday. If your child was born between:

- 1 January and 31 March they are eligible for Summer Term.
- 1 April and 31 August they are eligible for Autumn term
- 1 September and 31 December they are eligible for Spring Term

Note: if you are on maternity or paternity leave or if you are unable to work due to a disability or caring responsibilities you may still be eligible.
